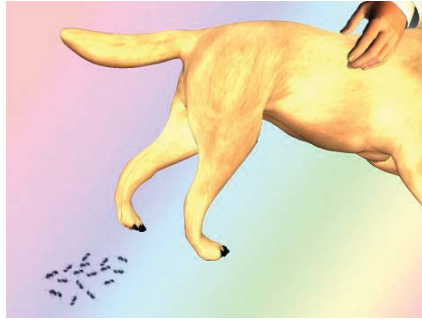


## Fire Ant Bite



**1**

Make sure you remove yourself and your dog from any source of fire ants and if needed hose them off your dog



**2**

Dampen a cotton ball with ammonia and dab it on the fire ant bite to relieve pain







**3**

If there is still some discomfort or swelling, apply a coldpack (wrapped in a towel) for 1-2 minutes to the site



**4**

Consult a vet if needed

-  Seek immediate veterinary care if your pet develops signs of severe allergic reaction such as: hives, severe swelling, breathing difficulties, vomiting & shock
-  For severe reactions, administer diphenhydramine (Benadryl) allergy tablets by mouth (1mg per pound of body weight) until veterinary help is available.
-  You may also use calamine lotion on the bite.
-  Be sure all ice or cold packs are wrapped in a towel before applying to sting site
